

**Minutes from the May 16, 2018 Meeting of the  
Board of Commissioners of the East Orange Parking Authority**

**Public Portion:**

A representative from Mayor Green's office informed the Board that the city is currently in the process of identifying solutions that will address overnight parking concerns. He mentioned that one resident in particular questioned why parking overnight is allowed on some streets but not others. He also mentioned that when streets are snowed covered and permit holders must remove their cars off the streets an alternate parking solution is needed, and that some Parking Authority lots may prove useful in resolving some of the parking concerns.
